

How can you measure the size of bass strings?

Take a paper band of 120-130 cm long, and the at the end of it make a hole.


Hang it to the left block, the inside pile on the first bass string, to upper Fis. Sign the wire at the left block and sign the wire of the long bridge on the right side.



Hang the paper band to the 15th bass string to the lower E and sign it to the same way. Sign the wire at the left block and sign the wire of the long bridge on the right side.




Hang the paper band to the second bass string to the upper F and sign the wire of the left side bass bridge and the wire of the right-side tuning block.




Hang the paper band to the lower F to the 14th sound and sign it at the same way. Sign the wire of the left side bass bridge and the wire of the right-side tuning block.



Push a paper to all piles at the bass part, on the left block.



Make a draw with the same size as the cimbalom is.
